Caregivers, seniors, and those with aging parents will find this to be a sensitive, scripture-based read with invaluable insight and personal experiences, as well as constructive counsel regarding the practical side of death.

Already acclaimed by Hospice and Stephen Ministry, *A Sacred Walk* is far more about living than dying, offering encouragement to both caregiver and care receiver, with poignant “living libraries” to strengthen, affirm, and draw one closer to a Spirit-filled life everlasting. The author is no stranger to death. She is able to use personal experiences and scripture-centered prayer to move the reader from anxiety through discouragement to trial and triumph.

Ms. Authers emphasizes, “Choose to believe in a loving God, to forgive the hurts of the past, and to love unconditionally.”
